## Intervention Strategies

- Reviewing student data on a minimum of 3x/year
- Identifying and articulating all Tier I, II and III interventions to students, parents, and staff members
- Continue tracking student data using RealTime Student Information System
- Participate in MAP Report Training
- Integrate MAP Data to IXL Platform for more individualized learning plans
- Explore additional Professional Learning Opportunities
- Infuse additional mathematics resources for mathematics instruction (6-8)
- Provide additional mathematics manipulatives for hands-on learning opportunities (K-2)
- Provide Professional Learning Community time to review supplemental materials
- Provide Professional Learning Community time to review student data
- Into Reading program adopted for K-5
- Review and update Math and ELA curriculum following release of New Jersey Student Learning Standards due to be implemented in September 2024
