

DRINKING WATER WARNING DO NOT DRINK THE WATER USE BOTTLED WATER

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

On September 25, 2019 Clifton E Lawrence School experienced a loss of positive water pressure due to a pump issue.

What should I do?

- **DO NOT DRINK THE WATER. Bottled water will be provided.**
- There is nothing you need to do. However, if you have specific health concerns, consult your doctor.
- If you have a severely compromised immune system, have an infant, are pregnant, or are elderly, you may be at increased risk and should seek advice from your health care providers about drinking this water.

What is being done?

An issue with the VFD booster pump caused pressure in the school to drop below 20 psi. The pump issue has been resolved and 3 distribution samples will be collected on 9/25/19 to determine if the water quality is satisfactory.
