

NTNC SERVICE LINE INVENTORY NEXT STEPS

We have identified your service line material as non-lead through visual inspection.

DEP's visit satisfies your water system's requirement to submit an initial service line inventory. DEP will be submitting your inventory information to EPA by the compliance deadline of October 16, 2024. Your water system is required to post the materials of your service line in a publicly accessible location. The second page of this document can be used to satisfy that requirement.

- If your service line is identified as non-lead (brass, copper, plastic, etc), you can say in that statement that your service lines are lead-free, or cite the materials specifically.
- If your service line was identified as lead or galvanized requiring replacement (currently or previously downstream from a lead service line), it will need to be replaced in accordance with EPA's Lead and Copper Rule Revisions by October 16, 2034. Non-profit NTNC systems are eligible for funding for lead service line replacement. You can find more information about our funding program here: <https://dep.nj.gov/wiip/>

EPA's Lead and Copper Rule Revisions mandates that we post the material of the service line that serves this water system. Our service line material is non-lead.

A service line is defined as the piping that transports water from the well to the building. If the material of the service line is lead or galvanized, it could have an impact on human health.
