

# **IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER**

## **Clifton E. Lawrence School Failed to Comply With a Testing Procedure**

Our water system Clifton E. Lawrence School recently failed to comply with a required testing procedure. Even though this was not an emergency, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we did to correct the situation.

*\*We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During June 2018, we did not complete all monitoring or testing for Total Coliform, and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of your drinking water during that time.\**

### **What should I do?**

There is nothing you need to do at this time. You may continue to drink the water. If a situation arises where the water is no longer safe to drink, you will be notified within 24 hours.

### **What is being done?**

On August 29, 2018 we collected a new sample of our finished water in order to have it analyzed for Total Coliform. We sent the sample to the certified lab via courier to ensure that the sample arrived within the allowed holding time. The sample was analyzed and Total Coliform was not found at detectable levels.
