On January 9, 2019 Clifton E Lawrence School experienced a loss of water pressure due to the well pump failing.

What should I do?

- DO NOT DRINK THE WATER. Bottled water will be provided in common areas, hallways, and classrooms.
- There is nothing you need to do. However, if you have specific health concerns, consult your doctor.
- If you have a severely compromised immune system, have an infant, are pregnant, or are elderly, you may be at increased risk and should seek advice from your health care providers about drinking this water.

What is being done?

Clifton E. Lawrence has repaired the blown fuse which powers the well pump, and normal water pressure was restored yesterday. 3 distribution samples will be collected on 1/10/19 to determine if the water quality is satisfactory.
