IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

On January 15, 2019 Clifton E Lawrence School experienced a loss of water pressure due to the school having to turn off the system's pumps to prevent them from burning out during repair to the local power lines.

What should I do?

- DO NOT DRINK THE WATER. Bottled water will be provided CE Lawrence School.
- There is nothing you need to do. However, if you have specific health concerns, consult your doctor.
- If you have a severely compromised immune system, have an infant, are pregnant, or are elderly, you may be at increased risk and should seek advice from your health care providers about drinking this water.

What is being done?

The electrical issue has been resolved and Clifton E Lawrence turned back on the pumps to restore water to the school. 3 distribution samples will be collected on January 16, 2019 to determine if the water quality is satisfactory.
