If your child is exhibiting any of the symptoms listed, click on the link that says [“Out Sick”](#) and complete the questionnaire and keep your child home.

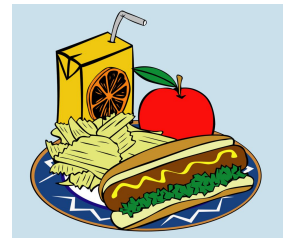


## Free Meals

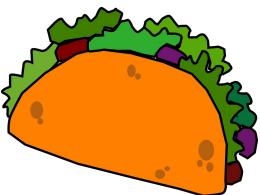

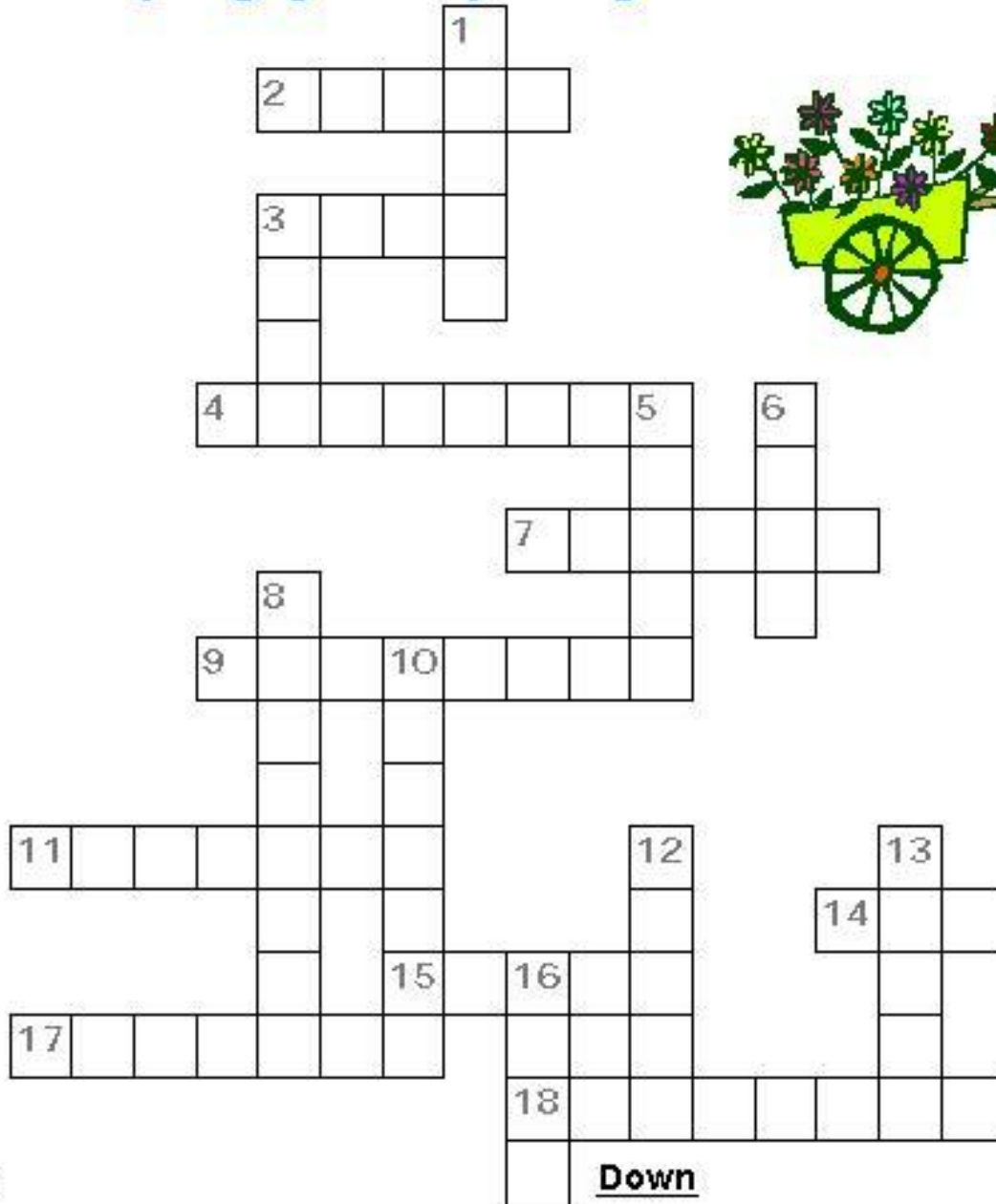
