*High and prolonged fever (102)

*Changes in mental condition, such

as not waking up or not interacting

*Bluish or gray skin color

*Drop in body temperature

*Difficulty breathing

*Not able to take in the usual amount of fluids

*Flu-like symptoms improve but then return with fever or worse cough

*Worsening of underlying medical conditions

Seek medical attention right away if your child presents any of these symptoms.



This is an opportunity which is available to all students. In order for your child to be seen, it has to be more than six months since your child has been to a dentist.


