During the week of April 17th, 2023 we will be covering Family Life during Health Education with the fifth grade students.

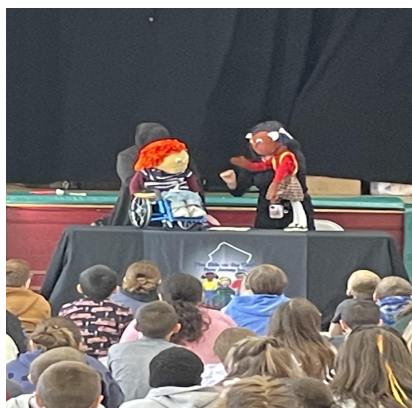
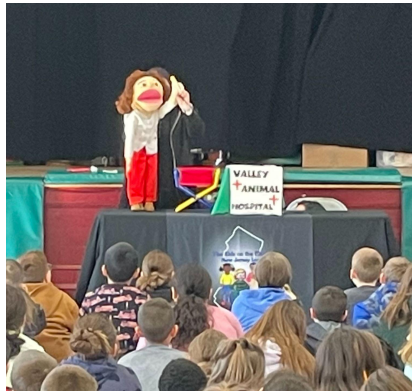
The Family Life Code includes a provision for excusing a student from any portion of the program.

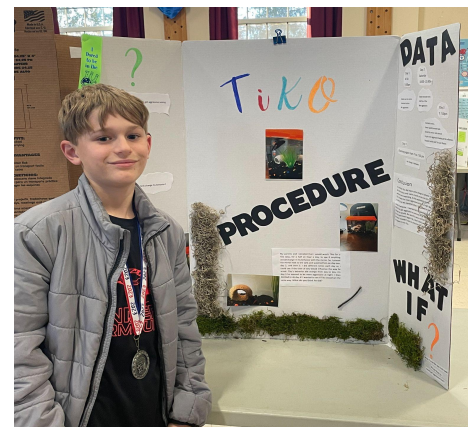
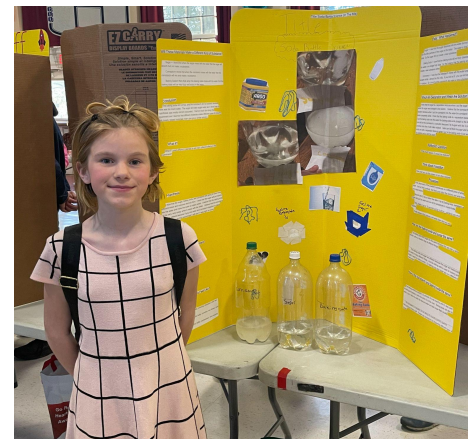

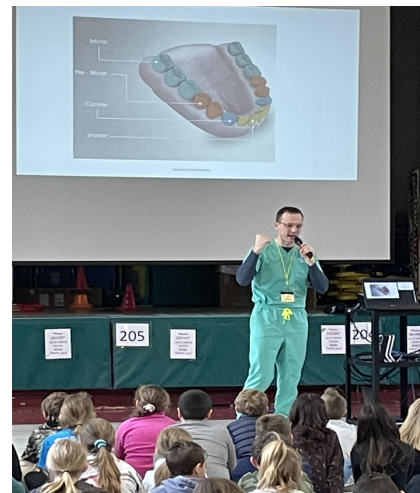
